Complex and Continuing Care Classroom Teacher

Bloorview School is a dynamic and innovative educational facility. It is located within a children's treatment centre and is operated under Section 68 of the Education Act. Bloorview School provides individualized educational programs for students from across the province.

The Complex and Continuing Care classroom is a unique setting serving students ages 9 to 21. This specialized program is for children and youth with complex physical, and/or communication disabilities and multi-faceted medical needs. For students in the Complex and Continuing Care classroom the length of stay in school depends on medical and therapy needs. Enrolment in school varies from student to student. Therefore, the turnover of students in the classroom is frequent and ongoing.

The successful applicant is versatile, flexible, able to teach in a multi-grade classroom setting, and has a strong commitment to collaboration and professional learning. The Complex and Continuing Care Classroom Teacher establishes the program, sets direction for the multi-disciplinary team and is responsible for student evaluation and assessment.

Summary of duties:

- Focus on communication, literacy and math skills as per the Ontario curriculum
- Develop and implement an individualized program
- Differentiate curriculum to support a range of cognitive abilities
- Provide alternative curriculum to meet the needs of students
- Develop and implement an Individualized Education Plan with appropriate modifications and accommodations
- Integrate technology into classroom programming
- Work with and support students with differing physical abilities
- Lead a multidisciplinary team (Educational Assistants and Deaf Blind Intervenors) to help students develop the necessary cognitive, language and social skills
- Actively engage students in the learning process
- Provide ongoing communication with families and home school
- Foster student self-esteem, self-regulation, independence, advocacy and well-being
- Facilitate and plan for student transitions
- Complete other related duties as assigned

Applicants must be permanent teachers with Special Education qualifications and a minimum of three years successful teaching experience.

This secondment is a one year renewable contract and is subject to the approval and protocols of Bloorview School Authority and the candidate's home School Board.
