

CALL FOR CANDIDATES

The Board of Trustees – Bloorview School Authority

Bloorview is one of six school authorities located in Children’s Treatment Centres in Ontario and mandated under Section 68 of the *Education Act*. The Bloorview School Authority is not under the jurisdiction of any of the local district school boards, and as such, has its own trustees, appointed by the Minister of Education.

Trustees are appointed to serve four year terms. The next term commences December 1, 2018. There is no honorarium for School Authority Board members.

Under the *Education Act*, in order to be qualified as a trustee on the board, an individual must be a resident of Ontario. An individual who is an employee of a district school board or school authority, or who has been convicted of an indictable offence, is disqualified from applying.
