Title: COMMON COMMUNICABLE CONDITIONS

Adopted: April 2020

Related Documents: Procedure HS - #2 Pediculosis (Head Lice).

PURPOSE

The Purpose of this procedure is to provide guidance regarding the steps to be followed if a student is identified as having a common communicable condition by the school (e.g. pink eye)

PROCEDURES

- Parents of children identified with a common communicable condition will be notified by the school and advised to contact Toronto Public Health at 416-338-7600 or toronto.ca/health and/or their family health care provider for more information and further resources.
- 2. If the child has missed school based on the severity of the condition, upon returning to school, the student is required to bring a note signed by a doctor giving clearance for the child to return. The note will be reviewed by the Principal or designate.
- 3. If a returning child is not free of the condition based on the observation of the Principal or designate, the family will be contacted.
- 4. All parents of children in a class in which a student or students are found to have a communicable condition will be sent a letter informing them of the fact. The letter will include a description of the condition and treatment if required.
