Bloorview School Authority Integrated Education and Therapy Program

Eligibility

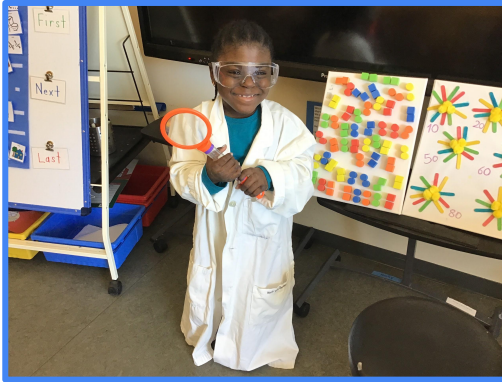
All students admitted to Bloorview School are Toronto residents and registered clients of Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital or York Region residents and clients of Children's Treatment Network.

Students have a primary diagnosis of a physical disability and other associated complex needs. Priority is given to applicants who demonstrate readiness to work on learning expectations as set out in the Ontario Kindergarten Program or Grade 1 Curriculum and who require a multidisciplinary approach for education and therapy.

The potential student:

- ★ demonstrates complex needs in two of the following areas:
 - Physiotherapy
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Speech and Language Therapy
- ★ is of legal school age (at least four years of age in December 31).
- ★ has the ability to tolerate a full day in a classroom setting and can attend to a range of activities for a short period of time.
- ★ is currently and actively participating in two or more therapies listed above, has demonstrated growth and shown the ability to integrate skills taught in daily-living activities.
- ★ demonstrates the ability to indicate through a communication strategy (e.g., body movement, verbal words, eye gaze, speech generating device, picture communication) the following:
 - yes/no responses
 - communication of choices

Integrated Education and Therapy



Bloorview School Authority

Bloorview School Authority is an educational facility that provides innovative school programs to children and youth with special needs. Every year hundreds of children and young people from across Ontario benefit from our individualized educational programs, which are set up in conjunction with ongoing therapeutic and medical care. Students must be clients of Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital, or the Children's Treatment Network in York Region.



The Integrated Education and Therapy Program (IET) is an interdisciplinary early intervention program for children with a range of physical and/or communication disabilities.

Physical, occupational and speech therapies are integrated into the child's day as part of the educational programming. The therapy is provided by professional therapists working in a team setting with special education teachers and educational assistants.

The teachers, therapists and support staff collaborate to establish individual learning and therapy goals and share the responsibility of programming for the goals of each student.

The classrooms are set up in a Universal Design for Learning model creating an inclusive environment. Appropriately designed space, furniture and equipment, augmentative and alternative communication systems, adapted technology and computer systems allow the child to gain the greatest benefit from the teaching and learning process.

This early learning environment maximizes a child's potential in communication, intellectual, physical and social skills development. Each child is encouraged to develop self-esteem, self-advocacy, independence and personal responsibility.

An Individual Education Plan is developed by the interdisciplinary team in consultation with the family to outline the strengths and needs of the students and to describe specific modifications, accommodations and strategies necessary to build success.

A school team supported by a School Transition Liaison teacher collaborates with the community school boards to ensure a successful transition when the student leaves Bloorview School.



Primary Programming

Bloorview School Authority offers a unique setting for students in Kindergarten to Grade One. The full day program is based on the Ontario Curriculum. Our approach is holistic and child-centred and based on the students' individual strengths and needs.

Our small classes allow for an academic focus on the acquisition of early literacy and numeracy skills to create the foundation for early learning. Library, music, visual arts, adapted physical education and aquatics enrich the weekly school timetable.
