

Intermediate/Secondary School Transition Liaison Secondment Opportunity – September 2025

Bloorview School Authority is a dynamic and unique educational facility located within Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital operating under Section 68 of the Education Act. Bloorview School provides educational programs for students 4-21 years old.

The Intermediate/Secondary School Transition Liaison (STL) facilitates and coordinates the transition of intermediate and secondary students from Bloorview School Authority to community schools upon and after discharge. Enrolment in school varies from student to student with the length of stay in school depending on medical and therapy needs. Therefore, the turnover of students in the classroom is frequent and ongoing. The STL will act as a contributing member of multi-disciplinary teams, which includes families, school board staff, community organizations, and Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital.

The successful candidate will be versatile, flexible, and have a strong commitment to collaboration and professional learning.

Reporting to the Principal, the Intermediate/Secondary School Transition Liaison will fulfill the duties as outlined below:

- Work collaboratively with Special Education Consultants, schools, and community organizations to plan for appropriate educational programming and ongoing support for clients of Holland Bloorview in Grades 6-10
- Coordinate, plan, and facilitate school transition meetings
- Facilitate and coordinate the transition of students from Bloorview School Authority to community schools
- Provide academic and transition counselling to students
- Provide educational consultation to teachers at Bloorview School and community school boards
- Provide consultation on the development of the Individual Education Plan (IEP), with appropriate accommodations, and modifications
- Promote an understanding on the effective use of technology, assistive devices, and adaptive equipment
- Other related duties as assigned

We seek applicants with the following professional qualifications and experience:

- Qualifications in Special Education (Specialist Qualifications preferred)
- Ontario College of Teachers Certification (Intermediate/Senior)
- Qualifications in Guidance an asset
- Knowledge of secondary courses and pathways; alternative modes of credit delivery; models of Student Success, Special Education, alternative programming options; transcript and OSSD requirements
- Experience working with students with acquired brain injury, physical and learning challenges, or complex needs an asset
- Applicants must be permanent teachers with a minimum of three years successful Intermediate/Senior experience

This position may involve travel to local school boards.

This secondment is a one year renewable contract and is subject to the approval and protocols of Bloorview School Authority and the Toronto District School Board.
