The Integrated Education and Therapy (IET) Program is a unique, specialized opportunity for children in Kindergarten and Grade 1 with physical disabilities, communication delays and/or complex medical needs. We offer small class sizes (up to 8 students), and physical, occupational, and speech therapies are incorporated into the school day.

Bloorview School teachers work collaboratively with multidisciplinary teams. Our teachers are committed to professional learning and leadership. The successful candidate will have a growth mindset, be versatile, flexible and skilled at teaching students with a wide range of learning needs.

Kindergarten and Grade 1 Teachers will:

- Focus on early communication, literacy, and math skills as per the Ontario Curriculum
- Differentiate instruction and assessment to support a range of physical and cognitive abilities
- Develop and implement Individualized Education Plans with appropriate modifications and accommodations
- Write Provincial Report Cards and Communication of Learning Reports
- Provide ongoing communication with families
- Integrate technology into classroom programming
- Lead a multidisciplinary team (Education Assistants and Therapists) to help students develop the necessary cognitive, language, and social skills
- Foster student self-esteem, independence, advocacy, and wellbeing
- Support students by teaching strategies for self-regulation and emotional regulation
- Support and physically assist students who have physical/mobility/behavioural/communication needs
- Complete other related duties as assigned
