

Transitions Liaison Teacher / SEA Lead Secondment Opportunity – September 2025

Bloorview School Authority is a dynamic and unique educational facility located within Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital operating under Section 68 of the Education Act. Bloorview School provides educational programs for students 4-21 years old.

The Transition Liaison Teacher and SEA Lead facilitates the transition of grade one students from Bloorview School's Integrated Education and Therapy program to community schools and coordinates the purchase and tracking of SEA equipment. This teacher also supports the Grade 1 teachers by working with small groups of students, providing IEP, assessment and programming support.

The successful candidate will be versatile, flexible, and have a strong commitment to collaboration and professional learning.

Reporting to the Principal, the Transitions Liaison Teacher and SEA Lead will fulfill the duties as outlined below:

- Coordinate and plan the school transition process in collaboration with the Program and Services Coordinator
- Facilitate the transition of students from Bloorview School Authority to community schools
- Provide ongoing support for families (regular check-ins, presentations, school visits, meetings with community schools)
- Provide educational consultation to elementary teachers at community school boards
- Promote an understanding on the effective use of technology, assistive devices, and adaptive equipment
- Oversee the SEA process: collaborate with therapists, source and order equipment, track budget, maintain database of records, complete Ministry of Education reporting, transport equipment to new schools
- Carry out school-based assessments and reading support for Grade 1 students
- Teach Advocacy sessions and Social Studies (prep coverage – approximately four classes a week)
- Other related duties as assigned

We seek applicants with the following professional qualifications and experience:

- Ontario College of Teachers Certification (Primary/Junior)
- Qualifications in Special Education (Specialist Qualifications preferred)
- Demonstrated proficiency with assistive technology
- Experience working with students with physical and learning challenges, or complex needs an asset
- Applicants must be permanent TDSB teachers with a minimum of three years successful experience

This position will involve driving to schools in Toronto and York Region.

This secondment is a one-year renewable contract and is subject to the approval and protocols of Bloorview School Authority and Toronto District School Board.
